Pictures of my sunburned right leg on night of august 01 2002 just before soaking a bucket of chlorinated water and removal of old skin and what appeared to be puss infected areas.

Pictures of my right leg the next day. I had soaked it twice the night before 45 minutes the first time followed by scraping of old skin, then another 30 minute soak in stronger chorine water followed by more scraping till the raw flesh was exposed to the air that had been covered previously by the necrotic skin tissue. Surprisingly the doctor today said any infection must have been surface only and the removal of the old tissue must have removed it. What remains is directly related to the sunburn, even 16 days later. Currently taking prednisone (cortico-steroid), an antibiotic called Amox-Clavo of 875mg size to ward off infection, and using some steroid cream on the remaining affected areas.
